

Union Co., NC ARES NET CALL PROCEDURE

Effective date:--September 30. 2002

(Net call to begin promptly at 8:30 pm local time each Wednesday evening)

This is **(YOUR CALL)**, calling the Union County ARES Net. My name is _____ and I am located in _____. This is a directed net, and is the 2 meter / 440 ARES net for Union County, North Carolina. All radio amateurs are invited to participate in the Union County ARES Net. An informal session will follow the formal portion of the net for those wishing to participate.

Stations with emergency or priority traffic should break into the net at any time.

(Allow repeater to drop.)

This net meets every Wednesday evening at 8:30 p.m. on NC4UC repeaters on 145.39 MHz and 444.425 MHz both with a 94.8 Hz tone.

(Allow repeater to drop.)

Stations are asked to check in to the net alphabetically by the first letter of the suffix of your call sign. Please call net control **(YOUR CALL), then give your call sign, followed by your name and listing of any announcements or traffic.**

Stations Alpha thru November please call **(YOUR CALL)**

Stations Oscar thru Zulu please call **(YOUR CALL)**

(Acknowledge all check-ins by group)

Please call **(YOUR CALL)**

(At this time, handle announcements followed by routine traffic, if any. Ask if there are any inquires pertaining to announcements).

We will now hold our weekly ARES meeting. Will the Union County ARES EC or representative please call now?

This is **(YOUR CALL)**

Announcements and training presented at this time by Union Co. ARES.

Please call (YOUR CALL)

This is (YOUR CALL) closing the formal portion of the Union County ARES Net at (LOCAL TIME). Those stations wishing to be excused from the net may now secure, all stations are invited to participate in the informal portion of the net which follows.

(call on stations, one at a time, to make informal comments)

(Periodically ask for additional check-ins during the informal part of the net.)

We now conclude this scheduled session of the Union County ARES Net at (LOCAL TIME), and thank the Union County Amateur Radio Society for the use of this repeater. I also thank all stations for participating and now returns the NC4UC repeater back to normal amateur use.
